**Format:** 18 hours of instruction (value of \$550), Use of the IU golf facilities, Access to State of the Art Equipment including-JC Video Swing Analyzer, TOMI Putting System and K-Vest. Personal work with PGA Professionals/ NCAA Division I coaches and Personal Strength Coach/Trainer. 2-18 Hole Rounds included on designated days also unlimited use of the Par 3 course on designated days;

**Fee:** \$350 per player
